2027 JUNIOR-PURCHASED FEMALE FUTURITY CLASS

Juniors who purchase a heifer in the 2026 NILE Red Angus Sale will be eligible to return and show that female in the 2027 Junior Purchased Female Futurity Class, where they can earn sale credit toward the 2027 sale.

Juniors will need to pay the \$50 futurity entry fee and be a Montana Junior Red Angus member. Females must be purchased by juniors at the time of the 2026 Prestigious NILE Red Angus Sale and they need to be transferred in the juniors' name.

Each female brought back to the futurity will receive \$250 sale credit toward current year NILE Red Angus Sale.

Grand Champion will receive an additional \$1,000 sale credit toward current year NILE Red Angus sale and Reserve will receive \$500 sale credit toward current year NILE Red Angus sale.

Junior-Purchased Females are also eligible to compete against the current year sale females for the overall champion.

Red Angus Guide to EPDS and Indexes

ProS – Profitability and Sustainability is an all-purpose index that predicts average economic differences in all segments in the beef supply chain. This index is a combination of the breeding objectives modeled in the HerdBuilder and GridMaster selection indexes. In this index, replacement heifers are retained from within the herd and all remaining progeny are fed out to slaughter and sold on a quality-based grid. Traits included in this index include CED, ADG, HPG, STAY, MW, DMI, CW, MARB, REA and Fat.

Index | Dollars per Head | Higher Value

HB – HerdBuilder is a maternal selection index that predicts the economic differences of animals for traits that are important from conception through weaning.

HB is calculated based on the scenario that bulls are mated to heifers and cows, replacement heifers are retained and all remaining progeny are marketed at weaning.

This index is a combination of CED, CEM, WW, Milk, MW, HPG and STAY.

Index | Dollars per Head | Higher Value

GM – GridMaster is a selection index that predicts the average economic difference of non-replacement calves through the post-weaning phase of production. GM places selection pressure on growth, feed yard performance and carcass traits.

GM is calculated based on the scenario that progeny are fed out to slaughter and marketed on a quality-based carcass grid. This index is a combination of ADG, CW, DMI, MARB, Fat and REA.

Index | Dollars per Head | Higher Value

CED – Calving Ease Direct predicts differences in the percent of calves born unassisted out of 2-year-old dams.

Percent | Higher Value

BW – Birth Weight predicts differences in actual birth weight of progeny. **Pounds | Lower Value**

WW – Weaning Weight predicts differences in 205-day weaning weight. **Pounds | Higher Value**

YW – Yearling Weight predicts differences in 365-day yearling weight. **Pounds | Higher Value**

ADG – Average Daily Gain predicts differences in weight gain between 205 and 365 days of age. **Pounds | Higher Value**

DMI – Dry Matter Intake predicts differences in daily feed intake as measured in a feedlot during the post-weaning period.

Pounds | Lower Value

MILK – Milk predicts differences in weaning weight attributed to the milking ability of the animal's daughters. **Pounds | Higher Value**

ME – Maintenance Energy predicts the difference in maintenance energy requirements. **Mcals per Month | Lower Value**

HPG – Heifer Pregnancy predicts differences in the percent of daughters who are able to conceive and calve at 2 years of age following exposure to breeding. **Percent | Higher Value**

CEM – Calving Ease Maternal predicts differences in the percent of daughters who are able to calve unassisted as 2-year-old heifers.

Percent | Higher Value

STAY – Stayability predicts differences in the ability of an animals' retained daughters to remain productive in the herd – calve every year – through 6 years of age. **Percent | Higher Value**

MARB – Marbling predicts differences in marbling score – amount of intramuscular fat measured at the 13th rib.

Marbling Score Units | Higher Value

YG – Yield Grade predicts differences in USDA Yield Grade, which is calculated using CW, REA and Fat. **Yield Grade Units | Lower Value**

CW – Carcass Weight predicts differences in actual hot carcass weight. **Pounds | Higher Value**

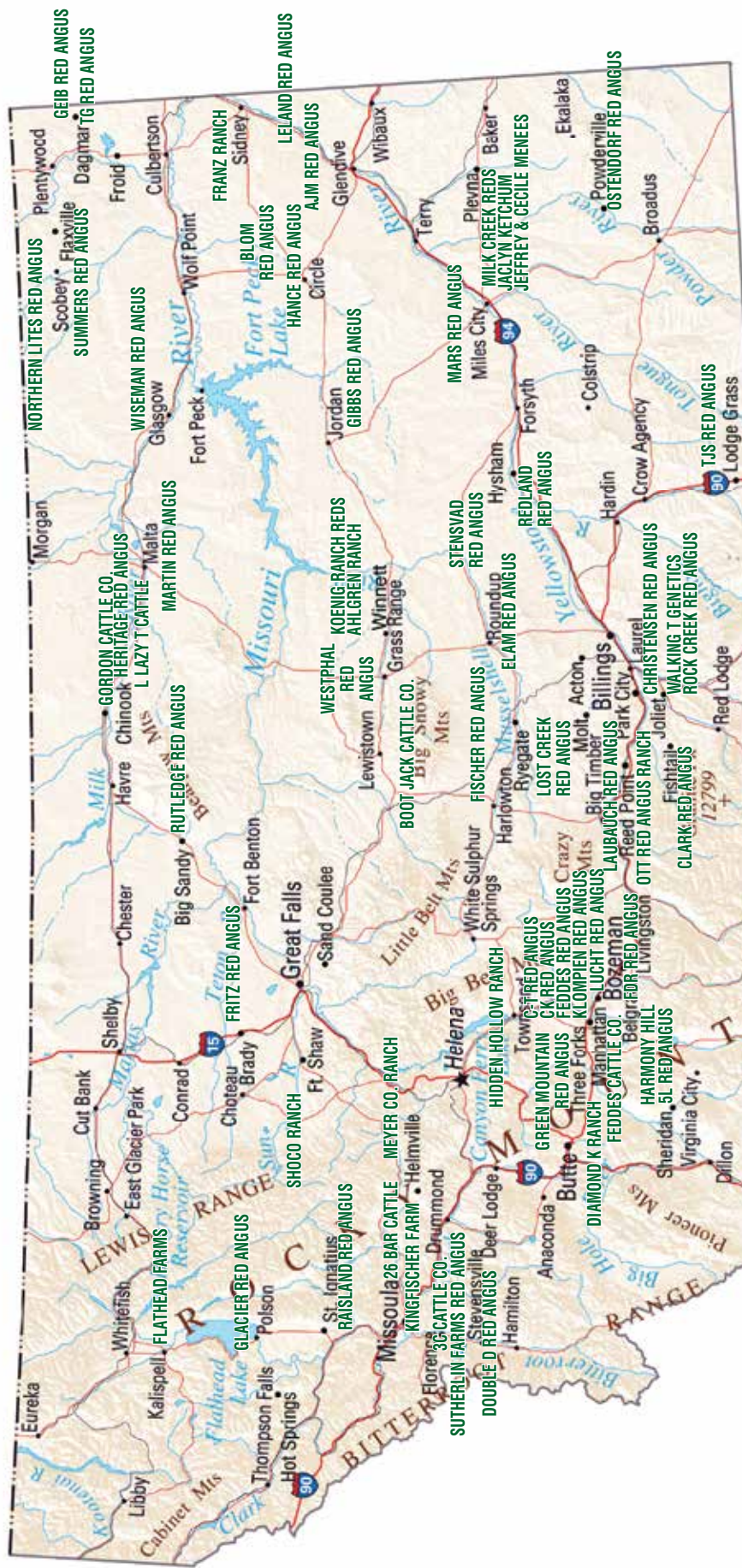
REA – Ribeye Area predicts differences in square inches of ribeye area measured at the 13th rib. **Square Inches | Higher Value**

FAT – Fat predicts differences in the depth of backfat measured between the 12th and 13th ribs. **Inches | Lower Value**

History of the Montana Red Angus Association

The Montana Red Angus Association (MTRAA) was officially organized on November 3, 1972. Several progressive breeders met at the Rainbow Hotel in Great Falls, MT. It was there that they elected officers and established by-laws. The first officers for the ensuing year were – President: Dave Cawlfeld, Vice-President: Jim Leachman, Secretary/Treasurer: Pete Stoltz.

MTRAA has a total membership of over 65 members, which includes both registered and commercial breeders from across Montana and a few other states. Annual dues are \$50 and payable by January 1st of the current year. Dues are to be sent to the Secretary/Treasurer. An annual meeting is held each October, in conjunction with the NILE. MTRAA happenings and membership listings can be found on our website at www.montanaredangus.org. We can also be found on Facebook.

Montana ranks as the largest register of Red Angus cattle in the Red Angus Association of America, with over 8,029 head registered this last year. Approximately 3,086 head of bulls were transferred to other breeders this last year. Montana is ranked ninth for regular memberships with 118 Montana members in the national organization. We also have 39 Montana Junior members within the RAAA, ranking us 10th.

MTRAA has always been progressive and leads the way in many programs. They are proud sponsors of the Prestigious NILE Red Angus Sale, which started in 1982. The sale is held in conjunction with the NILE annually in

October. This was the first sale to promote Red Angus cattle being sold by areas breeders. MTRAA is a proud sponsor of youth and established the County Buckle Program in 2000. This program honors all county fair champions that show cattle with Red Angus genetics. These champions are awarded a belt buckle for their achievements prior to the NILE sale. A female futurity was established in 2009. Current NILE sale animals and progeny of past sale animals are eligible to participate. This was established to showcase that the animals purchased at the NILE Sale work in the “real world.” The futurity is held annually in October at the NILE in Billings, MT. We also sponsor the Montana Stock Grower's Association Cattleman's College each year in Billings, MT.

In 1977, the first “Feeder Calf” sales were held in Billings and Butte. These sales have expanded to Three Forks, Miles City and Glasgow. October has been dubbed “Red October” as thousands of cattle are sold in these sales.

A Montana Tour is held in the fall on a rotation system that enables attendees to view cattle from both registered and commercial breeders across the state. The state is divided into seven regions, with the breeders in the area hosting the event. We invite you to join us for this annual event of extraordinary camaraderie, plenty of food, gracious hosts, good cattle and fun.
